The Lighthouse for the Visually Impaired and Blind (Lighthouse) Industry Program to provide job training and employment to people who are visually impaired and blind will offer job training and competitive employment opportunities to people who are visually impaired and blind in Pasco County. Individuals who can be transported from Hernando County will also be eligible for employment. This will be accomplished through an agreement to provide services to the Federal Government through the Ability One/ National Industries for the Blind procurement program. Our Primary customer will be the Veterans Administration (VA) and Respect of Florida State Use program.

### **Key Objectives:**

- ? Create jobs for people who are blind and visually impaired (20)
- Provide job training to people who are blind and visually impaired (30)

## Description:

The Lighthouse seeks to create employment opportunities for individuals who are blind and visually impaired in the Pasco/Hernando County area. This population faces an over 70% unemployment rate. In addition, the agency seeks to develop revenue to support rehabilitation services. Using a double bottom line approach, of creating employment and generating revenue, the Lighthouse Industry program will enhance and support the Lighthouse mission of ?providing people who are blind and visually impaired with the skills needed to achieve their maximum independence.?

The Lighthouse became an associated agency of the National Industries for the Blind nib.org in 2010. The Lighthouse leased a space on Pine Hill Road Port Richey

Florida in 2012 to get ready for operations in industry. The Lighthouse became an associate agency of the Respect of Florida, procurement set aside program in 2012. In 2013 the Lighthouse got 2 products on the procurement list for Respect of Fl. (shop towels and Zep Meter Mist products) through NIB partnerships. In 2014 LVIB got trash can liners on the Respect list.

The Lighthouse received non-recurring State of Florida general allocations of \$50,000.00 for the 2014-2015 and the 2015-2016 fiscal years. This funding has helped provide job training and employment to individuals who are blind.

The Lighthouse is now in the process of finalizing a contract to get the Ability One assignment for the Veterans Administration surgical isolation and decontamination gowns. This would require approximately 20 employees who are blind/visually impaired. These individuals need to receive training and on-the-job training to get to a competitive work level. Employment will include general clerical/administrative, packaging, and shipping and receiving. The Lighthouse will be working to get grants and private donations, but also needs additional funds to ensure provision of training to create successful employment outcomes. This program will be sustainable within 1 year.
