Employment training and placement, retirement program, recreational opportunities, case management services and residential options are a few of the programs offered to over 700 men and women with disabilities each year. The main center houses administrative offices, case management services, vocational testing services and a cafeteria that serves 400 meals a day, was constructed in 1966 and the roof has only been completely replaced once since. The roof has been patched and repaired several times and has leaks currently. After speaking to several roofing companies, they feel it is no longer ok to patch and repair. They feel a new roof is the only option.
