Program costs include \$25,000 for support of student OPS employees (peer educators) who will assist with the operation of, and gain skills through, the new specialized programs offered to support students and \$100,000 for program expenses (e.g. electronic resources, and licenses and career development events).

The entire student population of Florida Gulf Coast University will benefit from the targeted approach of these positions - addressing the Academic Student Life Cycle from entry into the university through graduation. Career advising and development, skill development, job placement, and preventative health initiatives are all focused on providing students with the skills and information necessary to complete their degree on time and improving our four year graduation rate while meeting employer demands to address identified talent gaps.
