The Central Florida Fair is a 501c-3 Non-profit hosting the Central Florida Fair for over 104 years. Providing education programs of Livestock and Horticulture for Orange, Seminole, Lake, Volusia, Brevard and Osceola youth. Over \$4.8+ million in premium cash awards to local residents for participation in the programs. \$100,000 in College Scholarships give to local Livestock youth since 1953. We currently host the Fair youth in a 50,000 sq. ft. open air pavilion built in 1986 through the State Agriculture Grant. Funds are requested for 2016 to renovate Livestock Pavilion roof and pillars that are in need of repair. A replacement roof and pillar repair of the pavilion will also add 15K sq. ft. of roof to increase our youth participation in Livestock pavilion which is capped currently with space and allow us to not have a lottery for positions in certain animal programs. We host over 750+ youth a year with over 1400 animals through the pavilion annually. As a district fair our youth come from 6 counties in Central Florida and we will use this pavilion renovation to continue to provide an educational program in Livestock to local youth while adding to our already \$36 million dollar impact to Central Florida.
