The Coral Gables Museum Green City Program serves K-12 students in Dade County and serves public, private and Charter school students. Composed of 9 curriculum components, the Program teaches students about environmental design through such elements as architecture, landscape architecture, design, urban planning as well as historic preservation. Operational expenses – include instructional materials & transportation 85%, \$170,000 Administration expenses – 15% Program faculty (one position), \$30,000 Match funding 25% - \$50,000 – to be used for supporting staff -The Program received the Outstanding Community Education Program Award from Dade County Schools in 2014. - Requested funding will be utilized to serve 12,000 Dade County students from public Private and Charter schools - Community support and cooperative efforts for the program include: Dade County Public Schools, Florida International University College of Architecture and the Arts, University of Miami School of Architecture and Historic Preservation Program Green Building Council The City of Coral Gables Comprehensive Program data collection is ongoing with evaluations provided by faculty and students involved in all program initiatives. Outcome measures are provided for all Program goals. Monthly and quarterly reports will be provided to the Department of Education, Dade County Schools, and Museum Board of Directors.
