In keeping with local and national trends and the desire to train students in high demand fields, the University is requesting a legislative allocation in the amount of 1.1 million dollars in order to develop and launch a Baccalaureate degree program in cybersecurity. According to U.S. News and World Report's Top 100 Jobs in 2015 list, information security analyst is the eighth best job in the United States and openings are expected to increase 36.5 percent by 2022. The Bureau of Labor Statistics lists median pay at \$88,890 per year, as reported in 2014. The State of Florida is listed among the top 10 states where cyber security professionals are in demand. Despite the existence of similar programs at other Florida institutions, demand exceeds supply. Florida Memorial University is uniquely positioned to increase the number of cyber security professionals from diverse backgrounds and contribute in meaningful ways to Florida's economy.

The total project cost is \$1,325,000.00 (\$1,100,000.00 from the State) - the difference will be funded by institutional operating budgets.
