Dixie County is a small county located between Taylor County to the North and Gilchrest County to the South. Dixie qualifies by Statute for "Special Facility Funding" for educational facilities. Dixie has gone through the statutory defined process and has been found to have a critical need for a new Middle/High school to replace the 50+-year-old facility currently being used. Dixie does not have any other means to build the needed school except with State assistance. Both the need and financial restraints have been recognized through a detailed evaluation process established by Florida law. Dixie also needs a third year of relief from local millage contribution as provided the previous two years. About 960 students will have the opportunity to receive both a traditional education or will be able to participate in one of about 5 different vocational technical educational programs. The Dixie County School Board filed the required resolution as directed by the State Department of Education. There is now a dispute as to project cost, but Dixie County is 2/3 through funding and significantly started on construction of the approved plans. DOE's proposed change cannot be reasonable accommodated at this late date.
