In keeping with local and national trends and the desire to train students in high demand fields, the University is requesting a legislative allocation in the amount of \$875,000.00 dollars in order to develop and launch a Baccalaureate degree program in Healthcare Informatics. \$150,000.00 has been allocated from the institutional operating budget. This sum will fund a program director, and a curricular consultant for the Phase 1 development of the program. Additionally, the FloridaBlue Foundation has committed \$20,000 toward the development of the program. Health informatics is a category that has become increasingly integrated into the management of clinical care—a development not yet reflected in official employment numbers. The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) tracks one type of health informatics position—medical records and health information technician—that accounts for only 60 percent of health informatics jobs. It ignores the growth in positions like supervisor and manager, auditor and compliance review staff, and clinical documentation and improvement specialists, as well as other less obvious applications like actuarial analysis in the insurance industry. These positions have become more skilled, with entry-level jobs upgraded, lower-skilled positions shrinking, and greater clinical knowledge required for higher-level jobs. The health systems are among the largest employment sectors in the State of Florida, and Florida Memorial University is uniquely positioned to increase the number of skilled health informatics employees, particularly from diverse backgrounds and contribute in meaningful ways to Florida's economy.

The total project cost is \$1,045,000.00 (\$875,000.00 from the State)- the difference will be funded by institutional operating budget and \$20,000.00 from FloridaBlue.

We would not anticipate more than maintenance costs beyond the first year to include salary support, scholarship support, and some recruiting resources- no more than \$250,000.00 total.
