Background:

Gadsden County is a small rural county consisting of six municipalities and is located in northern Florida. The county has one jail operated by the Gadsden County Sheriff's Office. Recently the Gadsden County Jail implemented a computerized Jail Management System to help effectively track its inmates' population.

Problem:

One of the biggest problems facing the Gadsden County Jail is reentry of inmates into society and workforce. Because over 80% of the inmate population are repeat offenders, with sentencing of one month or less, inmate reentry is a contributing factor to the systemic overcrowding at the Gadsden County Jail. The Gadsden County Jail was built to accommodate 157 inmates. On average, the jail houses over 250 inmates, more than 60% over capacity.

Solution:

In an effort to address reentry, the Gadsden County Sheriff's Office developed The Gadsden County Jail Chaplaincy Program in 2004. The Gadsden County Jail Faith Behind Bars Reentry Program will be vital in reducing recidivism. The program includes prerelease activities such as substance abuse counseling, anger management, employment skills, drug and alcohol awareness education, family counseling, job search training, and professional development.
