The Purpose of the JMCFF Hispanic Students College Bound Readiness Project is to assist Hispanic students in Miami-Dade County with college access resources through providing them with comprehensive hands-on college readiness informational sessions with experts on a variety of topics including: college application preparation, SAT/ACT test registration, test strategy sessions and tutoring, financial aid assistance seminars, scholarship application assistance, individual and or group counseling, Florida college tours, college student support services aimed at increasing the number of Hispanic students entering college.

The targeted group of students would be Hispanics students residing in Miami-Dade County. The funding requested would be utilized to operate the information sessions (one Saturday per month), venue costs, college prep books and test prep book materials for students, costs associated with bringing session speakers and experts to sessions, funding will include cost for project staff to assist in the preparation and coordination of all project activities, transportation costs to bring students to attend information session venues, events and college tours. The number of sessions will serve up to 3,000 students. The funding would be used for the entire project, which does not include capital costs.
