The City of St. Petersburg is seeking funds to construct an exclusive northbound left-turn access ramp from 4th Street South at Interstate 175. To date, the City has contributed \$400,000 for the two-way conversion and design of the current I-175 Interchange modification, yet traffic is still forced to travel a circuitous route and some drivers choose to make an illegal u-turn maneuver to avoid the delays associated with the designated route. The roadway network lacks northbound left-turn access directly from 4th Street South to the I-175 westbound on-ramp. The new ramp will provide more direct access for northbound motorists to reduce travel time and mitigate current traffic congestion in the City's hospital and Innovation District. An existing westbound dual free-flow ramp can be converted to a single lane free flow ramp making this project significantly more cost-effective.

Beneficiaries include the residents and visitors of St. Petersburg in the vicinity of I-175 and 4th Street, and specifically those conducting business with the University of South Florida St Petersburg, All Children's Hospital/Johns Hopkins Medicine, Bayfront Health St. Petersburg (formerly Bayfront Medical Center), Albert Whitted Airport/St. Petersburg Port, the Dali Museum, and the Mahaffey Theater.
