The House GAA, in Specific Appropriation 205, provides for a Graduate Medical Education (GME) Startup Bonus Program. However, "General Pediatrics" has been left out of the listed specialties eligible for the program. General pediatrics is a critical subspecialty and Nemours Children's Hospital (NCH) is launching their GME program for general pediatrics in FY16-17 in order to help meet need in Florida. Accordingly, Nemours would like to access the GME startup bonus program funding for the new "general pediatrics" program. Therefore, NCH proposes that "General Pediatrics" be added to the list of physician specialties and subspecialties contained in the proviso associated with Specific Appropriation 205 that are in statewide supply/demand deficit. A core general pediatrics residency program is an Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) prerequisite to initiating pediatric subspecialty fellowships in a training institution, including those fellowships that have a determined need in the state of Florida. NCH has the subspecialty expertise to facilitate the training of pediatric subspecialists in NCH programs, and as a potential teaching site for other institutions, but currently NCH is not able to allow other trainees to tap into its physician expertise due to the need to build a resident "cap" under the CHGME funding rules. That "cap" building must start with the general pediatric residents as stated above.
