The City of LaBelle Civic Center is the largest publicly available gathering space on the Western side of Hendry County. The facility host numerous events ranging from civic functions, to chamber events, dances and, quite frankly any gathering of more than 150 people. Two such examples include the "Old Timers Dinner" during the annual Swamp Cabbage Festival and the Gulf Citrus Growers Annual Gala. In addition, other groups including Hendry County Cattlemen's and several student organizations have expressed interest in utilizing the facilities however, the disrepair of the restroom facilities have been the primary limiting factor. Although located on the western part of the county, the 39,000 +/- citizens throughout Hendry County have utilized or benefit from the Civic Center. Although not a majority of the use, the civic center has hosted regional civic gatherings which residents from Collier, Glades and Lee Counties have also been able to attend and enjoy.

The funds requested are nonrecurring and will be used to pay for the materials, construction and engineer cost associated with the facility. The City of LaBelle is also adding some "skin" to the project, approximately \$35,000 to begin work on the deteriorating bathroom facilities at the Civic Center.
