The Collier Campus was originally constructed in 1991, and the multiple affected buildings represent the original structures. External Foam Insulation System (EFIS) building envelope was used on these original buildings. Over the nearly 25 years of service to the public, the EFIS has begun to separate from the underlying structure and has allowed moisture to penetrate the building. The damage caused by the water intrusion represents an annual cost of repair that has been absorbed by the college through normal Ren/Rem cycles or local funds for many years. Requesting the \$8,000,000 for the complete removal of the EFIS and replacement of a more suitable building envelope would end the constant and wasteful annual patch and repair cycles. Accomplishing this one-time removal & replacement would allow the institution to address other deferred maintenance needs across our college. This would therefore extend the service life of not only the affected buildings, but all other buildings with other deferred maintenance needs. The Collier Campus is situated in close proximity to the Florida Everglades and the regional environmental conditions include months of tropical moisture, months of arid heat and many other conditions that have led to the expansion and contraction of the EFIS material causing the cracking, separation and breaking down of the EFIS material. All of this has allowed the water intrusion, structural damage and the need to develop an immediate solution to end the patch & repair cycle.
