Tampa Hillsborough Homeless Initiative (THHI), the lead agency for the Continuum of Care, is requesting \$2,000,000 to implement Taking It To The Streets. Taking It To The Streets in a new project focused on reducing homelessness in the City of Tampa and Hillsborough County. Based on the annual homeless count, over the last 12 months our community has worked aggressively together to reduce homelessness. The Tampa and Hillsborough County community has reduced the number of people sleeping on our streets and places not meant for habitation by 31%. The funding for Taking It To The Streets will allow THHI to work with our partners to continue this momentum. The funds would be used to establish community housing solution centers and permanent supportive housing.

Taking It To The Streets is an aggressive outreach and housing effort. Several mobile outreach teams trained in Assertive Community Treatment will be critical to this effort. The outreach teams will conduct street-level engagement and assessments. Each mobile outreach team will be attached to a Community Housing Solutions Center (CHSC).
