In its most recent Work Plan, Florida Gulf Coast University listed two key initiatives: "Academic Quality" and "Return on Investment". The latter effort will leverage existing and new resources to offer programs that meet the demand of current job openings in one of the fastest growing industries, improve graduation rates and further enhance post-graduation employment success. To that end, FGCU has, in consultation with regional business partners, developed three degree programs to address specifically identified employment talent gaps. These professionally focused programs, attractive to high-achieving students, are intended to address key regional needs in Southwest Florida and, more broadly, the State of Florida and will impact the construction, manufacturing, logistics, and analytics sectors of our economy. Therefore, FGCU requests funding for the development of targeted degrees to focus on: Construction Management, Supply Chain Management, and Business Analytics/Informatics.
