The Little Econ Greenway Phase 3 will be a multi-user trail consisting of a 1 mile long 14-foot wide asphalt surface from Forsyth Road to SR 436 and a trail bridge over SR 436. The estimated cost to construct Phase 3 is \$8.7 - \$9.8 million. The project serves to close an important gap in the east Orange/Seminole Counties trail network. It will link together the 7.9-mile Little Econ Greenway with the 6.5-mile Cady Way Trail and the 5.5-mile Cross Seminole Trail. The trail bridge will span SR 436, a six-lane divided highway with a 50 mph speed limit that presents a significant barrier to safe travel by trail uses.

Approximately 50% of the corridor has been acquired. Parcels on the east end of the project were acquired for the trail between June 2002 and June 2003 by deed and ROW reservation. Parcels on the west end around SR 436 were acquired for the trail bridge and the East-West Connector Road between May 2006 and June 2009 by deed and easements. The easement area in the center of the project does not extend far enough north of the adjoining canal to provide adequate room for the trail. The County will need to acquire this corridor which has an estimated value of \$400,000.
