Project Description: \$428,476 in Recurring state funds are requested to support 3.3 positions and other support expenses; \$593,000 in Non-recurring state funds are requested for electronic data processing costs, online course development and educational workshops for the development of a new and simple-to-use technology that will transform tourism analytics and research capabilities, with improved marketing strategies and outcomes. Currently, there are products produced in the marketplace that provide some of this type of information, but these products do not address all of the issues, as envisioned in this proposal, and also are not easy for all anticipated government entities and businesses to use. As a part of this proposed pilot project, UF's Tourism Institute will work with Visit Florida and visitor bureaus in St. Augustine, Jacksonville, and Amelia Island in order to develop a prototype web-based intelligence platform known as SMART NE Florida. The focus will be on the Northeast Florida Vacation Region comprising of Nassau, Duval, Baker, Clay, St. Johns, Putnam and Flagler counties which is a region that has huge growth potential, but could use some additional tools for analyzing and expanding the numbers of visitors and expenditures, hotel rates, and tourism infrastructure development. In developing the prototype, UF will dedicate faculty who are experts in tourism marketing and outreach, outdoor recreation, coastal zone management, community development, design of information technology, and data analytics.

Proposed Deliverables are: 1) An operational online platform for data acquisition and analytics that is easy-to-use and accessible for NE Florida businesses and government; 2) 12 workshops across the region to train users on platform operation; 3) an operating manual and educational materials for users; 4) a UF-Based Support Center with a dedicated website, e-mail and phone access to support the various users.

Return on Investment. Regional use of the new technology is predicted to yield 3.5% increases in annual travel spending, travel-generated payroll, travel-generated employment, travel-generated state tax receipts, and travel-generated local tax receipts. Based on 2013 Visit Florida data, these increases are estimated to generate new jobs totaling between 1,350 and 2,250 with a financial impact totaling \$156-\$260M per year. Development of the new technology

will transform tourism analytics and research, thus establishing UF as a world leader in this area, supporting UF's Land Grant mission. This initiative will serve as a pilot project to establish proof of concept. Once proven, the technology could be extended to other regions of the state.
