The USF FDLRS Centers serves students, educators, and families in the school districts of Hillsborough, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk, Hernando, Sarasota, Manatee, DeSoto, and Charlotte. FDLRS is a network of 6 university centers established in the early 1980s to provide diagnostic evaluation services for school-aged children and youth, along with consultation, technical assistance, and pre-service/in-service training for educators, families, and communities. The Centers provide specialized services for students who have complex medical, cognitive, social/behavioral, developmental, and learning needs and who are at greatest risk of being unsuccessful in school, both academically and socially. Most of the funds appropriated each year (\$430,000 of the \$450,000) pays salaries and benefits of personnel who provide the direct and indirect activities aimed to improving the academic and social success of school-aged students. Proviso each year (Line Item 97 in the GAA for FY 15-16) requires all FDLRS Centers to submit an annual report to the FLDOE that shall include the following: (1) the number of children served, (2) the number of parents served, (3) the number of persons participating in in-service education activities, (4) the number of districts served, and (5) specific services provided. Services provided help resolve student problem behavior and allow the child to remain in their school or home and become increasingly engaged in academic work.
