New House Language

Section XX. In order to implement the appropriation of funds in the appropriation category "Data Processing Services-State Data Center-Agency For State Technology (AST)" in the 2015-2016 General Appropriations Act, and pursuant to the notice, review, and objection procedures of s. 216.177, Florida Statutes, the Executive Office of the Governor may transfer funds appropriated in that category between departments in order to align the budget authority granted based on the estimated billing cycle and methodology utilized by the Agency For State Technology for data processing services provided by the State Data Center. This section expires July 1, 2016.
