Notwithstands s. 259.105, F.S.</p> <p>Allocates \$25m to the DACS for the acquisition of agricultural lands through perpetual conservation easements and other perpetual less-than-fee techniques; \$100m to the DEP to be distributed to the WMDs per subsection (12) to fund water resource development projects; \$50m to DEP for land acquisition including less-than fee interests, and capital projects that contribute to the restoration of the quality or quantity of water flowing from Priority Florida Springs or by supporting attainment of a TMDL or achievement of a MFL for a Priority Florida Spring; or capital projects to implement 403.067(7)(a)8. which support attainment of a TMDL for a Priority Florida Spring. 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16A			<p>DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS FROM THE LAND ACQUISITION TRUST FUND WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION TO OTHER AGENCIES' LAND ACQUISITION TRUST FUNDS. <u>For fiscal year 2015-2016, requires the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), after subtracting required debt service payments, to transfer monthly a proportionate share of the revenues deposited into the Land Acquisition Trust Fund within the DEP to the land acquisition trust funds in the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, and Department of State, based upon DEP's and those agencies' proportionate shares of the total appropriations from land acquisition trust funds for the fiscal year. Total distributions to a land acquisition trust fund in the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, and Department of State may not exceed the total appropriations from that trust fund for the fiscal year.</u></p>		SENATE MODIFIED
