6 Remove lines 97-110 and insert:

7 (d)1. Early voting shall begin on the 10th day before an
8 election that contains state or federal races and end on the 3rd
9 day before the election, and shall be provided for no less than
10 6 hours and no more than 12 hours per day at each site during
11 the applicable period. In addition, early voting may be offered
12 at the discretion of the supervisor of elections on the 15th,
13 14th, 13th, 12th, 11th, or 2nd day before an election that contains
14 state or federal races, for no less than 6 hours and no more
15 than 12 hours per day at each site, up to a maximum of 14 days
16 of early voting. The supervisor of elections may provide early
17 voting for elections that are not held in conjunction with a
18 state or federal election. However, the supervisor has the
19 discretion to determine the hours of operation of early voting
20 sites in those elections.

21 2. For gubernatorial and presidential general elections,
22 early voting shall begin on the 10th day before an election and
23 end on the 2nd day before the election, and shall be provided
24 for no less than 6 hours and no more than 12 hours per day at
25 each site during the applicable period. In addition, early
26 voting may be offered at the discretion of the supervisor of
27 elections on the 15th, 14th, 13th, 12th, or 11th day before an
28 election, for no less than 6 hours and no more than 12 hours per
29 day at each site, up to a maximum of 14 days of early voting.
