11 (b)1. If it is determined that the person was registered
 12 and entitled to vote at the precinct where the person cast a
 13 vote in the election, the canvassing board shall compare the
 14 signature on the Provisional Ballot Voter's Certificate and
 15 Affirmation with the signature on the voter's registration and,
 16 if it matches, shall count the ballot.

17 2. If a supervisor of elections determines that a person
 18 voting by provisional ballot is not registered or entitled to
 19 vote at the precinct where the person cast a provisional ballot,
 20 the provisional ballot shall be counted for all races not unique

21 to that particular precinct. Votes unique to that precinct shall
22 not be counted. ~~If it is determined that the person voting the~~
23 ~~provisional ballot was not registered or entitled to vote at the~~
