2. Be a United States citizen or a lawfully residing
immigrant;

3. Be uninsured and ineligible for Medicaid; and

or the spouse of an individual or a parent or caretaker relative
living in the same household, of a child under age 18 whose
household income does not exceed 133 percent of the federal
poverty level based on the most recent federal tax return, or,
if a tax return was not filed, the most recent monthly income;
or

b. Be a person who receives payments from, who is
determined eligible for, or who was eligible for but lost cash
