House / Senate Budget Conference Tentative Schedule

Pursuant to House Rule 7.22, conference committees are authorized to begin noticed meetings at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 27, until 12:00 p.m. on Friday, April 29, at which point any unresolved conference issues will be bumped to the budget chairs.

As this year's host, the Senate President has asked that conference committee chairs avoid meeting during pre-scheduled Floor sessions or standing committee meetings. I would ask House Members to respect that request. Members should anticipate the House recessing from scheduled Floor session each day this week from 12:15 p.m. until 1:15 p.m. to allow time for conference meetings. Conference committee members should also anticipate morning and evening meetings outside of our scheduled Floor session.
